



Vaccine Policy

Vaccines prevent serious illness and save lives. Vaccines are safe. Vaccines do not cause autism or other developmental disabilities. Vaccinating children and young adults may be the single most important health promoting intervention we perform as physicians, and that you can perform as parents/caregivers.

If it is your decision to decline to vaccinate your child according to our recommendations, we will ask you to find another health care provider, recognizing that by not vaccinating on schedule you are putting your child at unnecessary risk for life threatening illness, disability, and even death.

As medical professionals, we feel very strongly that vaccinating children on schedule with currently available vaccines is absolutely the right thing to do for all children and young adults.
